The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Election Day Act.-Unlawful Voting-Misrepresent identity--apply for or deposit ballot or attempt vote**

Minnesota Statute: 204C.14(a)

Maximum Sentence: 10 years and/or \$20,000

On or about July 27, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Michelle Marie Landsteiner did intentionally misrepresent the individual's identity in applying for a ballot, depositing a ballot in a ballot box or attempting to vote by means of a voting machine or electronic voting system.

**STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE**

On August 22, 2016, Detective Jerry Billiar with the Blue Earth County Sheriff's Office received information from the director of taxpayer services at Blue Earth County regarding suspicious circumstances of a ballot that was received on or about July 27. Initially the ballot had been accepted because the signature envelope was completed appropriately; however, when inputting the receipt of the ballot into the voter system, a flag on the voter record appeared stating the record would be inactivated July 10, due to an out of state move of Resident 1 to Chicago, Illinois.

Due to the voter's age and provisions in the law that allow students to vote at home if that is still their permanent residence, Detective Billiar called to investigate. Detective Billiar called the phone number on the voter record and several days later spoke with Resident 1. Resident 1 indicated to Blue Earth County officials that she did not vote and that Illinois was her permanent home. When officials indicated they had received a ballot and that is why they were calling, Resident 1 stated she may have forgotten that she voted.

In investigating the matter further, Detective Billiar learned that Resident 1 previously lived in a 'mail ballot precinct,' meaning that Blue Earth County automatically sends a ballot to all eligible voters indicated in the voter record system. Further, that on or about June 21, the print vendor downloaded a file of eligible voters and mailed the ballots June 24. The ballot in question was received July 27 and was signed by a witness, Shelly Landsteiner, with the same address as Resident 1. There were other Landsteiner ballots returned the same day and Detective Billiar noted that the printed information on the signature envelope was very similar in the voter section and the witness section.

On August 24, 2016, Detective Billiar made cell phone contact with Shelly Marie Landsteiner and explained he needed to sit down with her and discuss an issue regarding a voting ballot. On or about September 14, 2016, at approximately 2:35 p.m., Detective Billiar conducted a recorded interview with Michelle Marie Landsteiner, the defendant herein, at the Criminal Justice Center. The interview was recorded. Landsteiner was advised that she was not under arrest and she was not going to be under arrest, that she could leave at any time, and that she did not have to answer Detective Billiar's questions if she did not want to.

Landsteiner reported Resident 1 lives and works in Illinois and has for the last two years. She reported a ballot still comes for Resident 1 to their home address. She indicated she did not know of the process of changing the address but that as long as there was a ballot coming, Landsteiner was going to use it to vote. Landsteiner reported she had talked to Resident 1 about the ballot and that because Resident 1 wasn't there and couldn't fill out the form, Landsteiner filled it out for her.

Landsteiner reported Resident 1 told her who to vote for and what to do over the phone. Landsteiner was shown a copy of the ballot envelope and admitted that she had forged Resident 1's signature on the back of the ballot envelope and then signed her own name as the witness. Landsteiner stated 'I know it isn't the proper way to do it, but you know as long as I have a ballot, I try to teach my girls civic duties, you know?' Landsteiner did not recall what day she filled out the ballot and envelope but agreed it was sometime in July. Landsteiner indicated Resident 1 moved out a couple of years ago but still has a Minnesota driver's license.

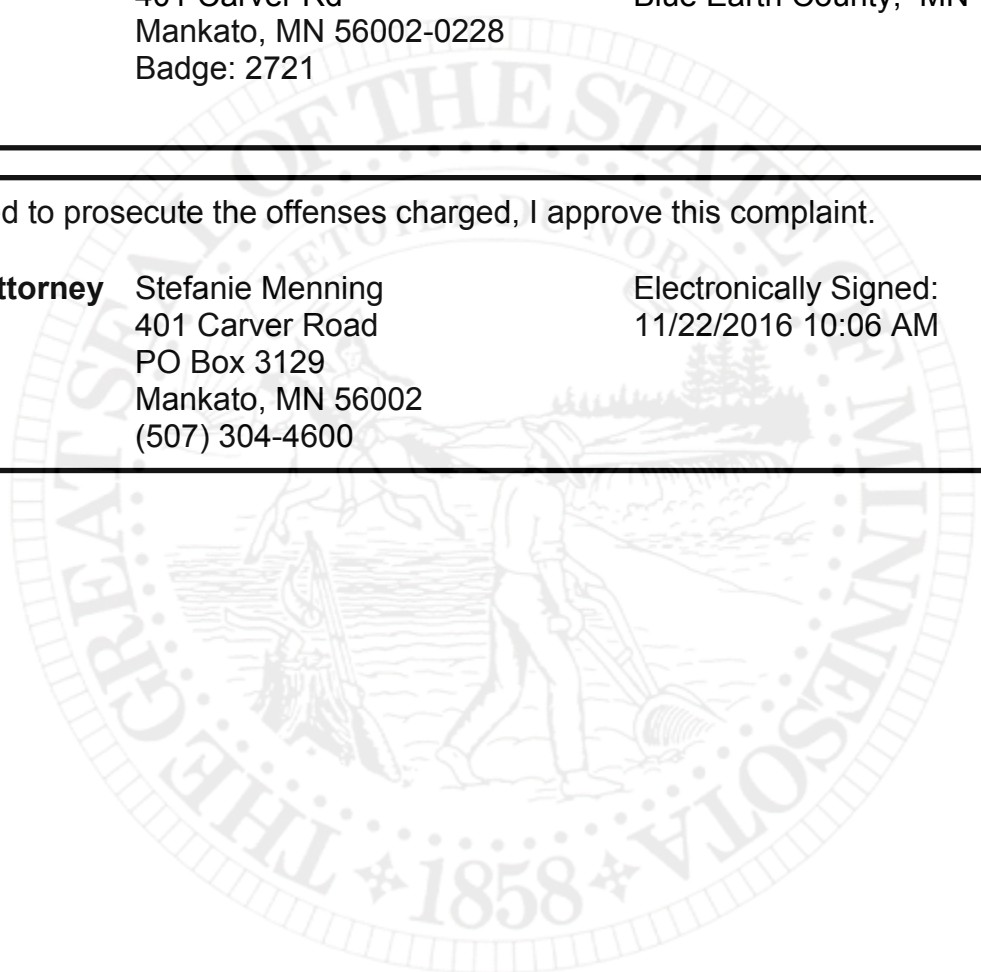



On or about November 8, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Ashley Nicole Williams did vote after having been previously convicted of treason or any felony and their civil rights had not been restored.

**STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE**

On Monday, May 1, 2017, Detective Jerry Billiar of the Blue Earth County Sheriff's Office received information from Witness 1, the Director of Taxpayer Services for Blue Earth County, regarding a voter law violation by Ashley Nicole Williams. Witness 1 indicated that Williams voted in the 2016 General Election and that her civil rights had not been restored after a felony conviction.

The information provided indicated that Williams had been convicted of a felony in Blue Earth County Court File No. 07-CR-06-810. Williams had not received any voting history for the election, so the record had been marked inactive due to the annual list maintenance completed by Secretary of the State.

According to Taxpayer Services records, Williams registered on Election Day in Mankato Precinct 3 and began the voter registration application but did not sign it. It appears the election judge completed the bottom portion, which indicates the application was submitted for processing. Williams signed the voter roster indicating she completed the registration process to vote, which includes an oath regarding eligibility. The voter registration application was then processed, and Williams proceeded to vote.

On May 3, 2017, Detective Billiar checked local records and found a listing for Williams in the City of Mankato. Detective Billiar also conducted a driver's license search and found Williams has a valid Minnesota driver's license listed in December 2016 with a Mankato address.

Additionally, Detective Billiar reviewed the Statewide Supervision System and observed that Williams was on probation with Blue Earth County Community Corrections, showing a prison obligation commencement date of June 2013 with a release in July 2014. The records also showed Williams remains on probation until August 2019. It should be noted that the Minnesota Voter Registration Application included the handwritten name of Williams and that the General Election Form was signed by Williams. This information showed Williams registered and voted in the 2016 General Election despite being ineligible. It is against the law to register to vote in Minnesota and to vote in Minnesota when one is ineligible to do so.

On August 1, 2017 Detective Billiar spoke with Williams by telephone. Williams admitted to registering and voting in the 2016 election.

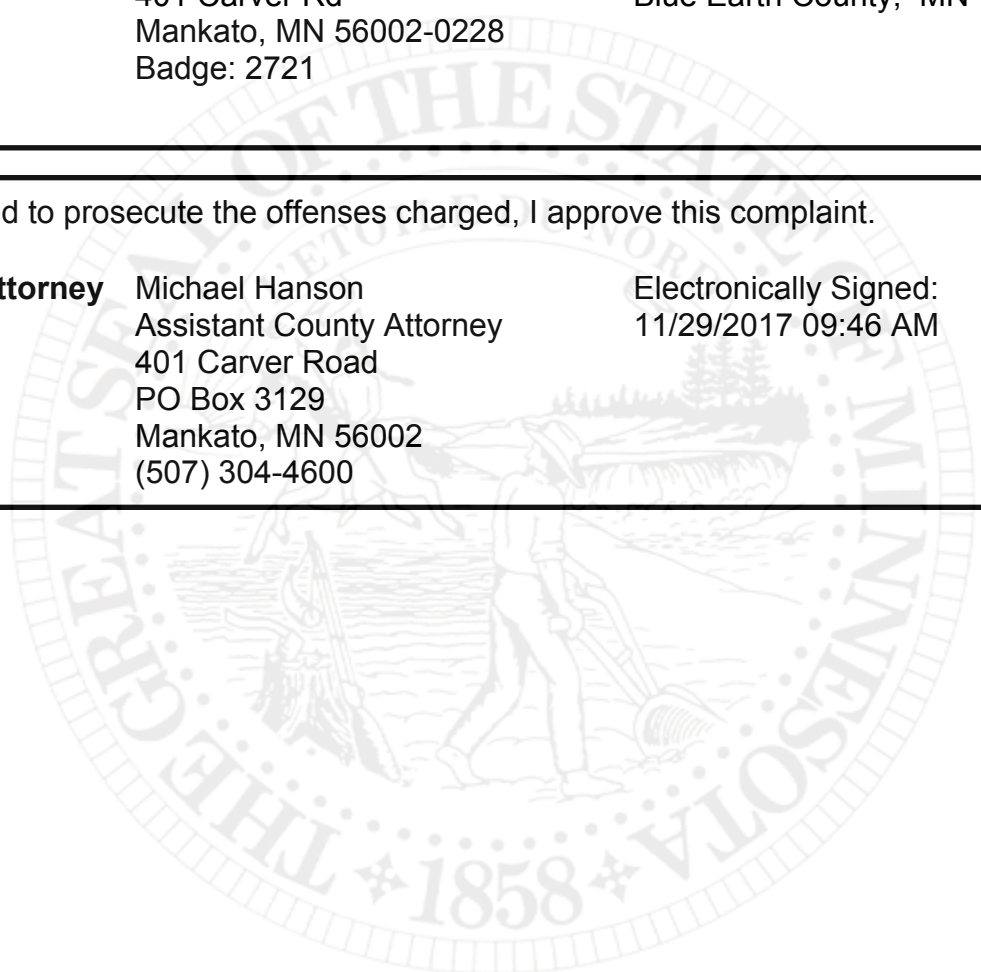



On or between September 27, 2016 and November 8, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Noah Summers did intentionally cause or attempt to cause the individual's name to be registered in any precinct if the individual is not eligible to vote.

**STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE**

On May 1, 2017 Detective Jerry Billiar with the Blue Earth County Sheriff's office was contacted by Witness 1, the director of taxpayer services for Blue Earth County, regarding a possible voter law violation by Noah Summers. Summers had registered to vote while ineligible.

Witness 1 provided the voter registration indicating that the voter registration went through the Minnesota Driver and Vehicle Services. DVS had an option on Summers' driver's license renewal or application to update voter registration. A copy of the Statewide Voter Registration System printout showed that on September 27, 2016, a voter record and setting status of 'active' was entered as online data source. The transaction was processed by elections staff.

On October 31, 2016, the status was listed as 'challenged - felony' for the Precinct of Blue Earth County - Mankato - 100.

On May 2, 2017, Detective Billiar checked local records for Summers and found his driver's license was cancelled inimical to public safety. Additionally, Detective Billiar reviewed and printed the online voter registration instructions. The instructions list voter eligibility in Minnesota, including #6 indicating 'You have not had your voting rights revoked by a court of law.'

Detective Billiar reviewed the Statewide Supervision System showing Summers has a Mankato address and is on supervised probation, with a projected end-date of September of 2019. Based on records, Summers was registered to vote in Blue Earth County's jurisdiction while on supervised release in violation of election laws.

On July 25, 2017 Detective Billiar spoke with Summers by telephone. Summers confirmed that he is still currently on probation but denied voting in the 2016 election. Summers stated he may have registered to vote online but could not recall.

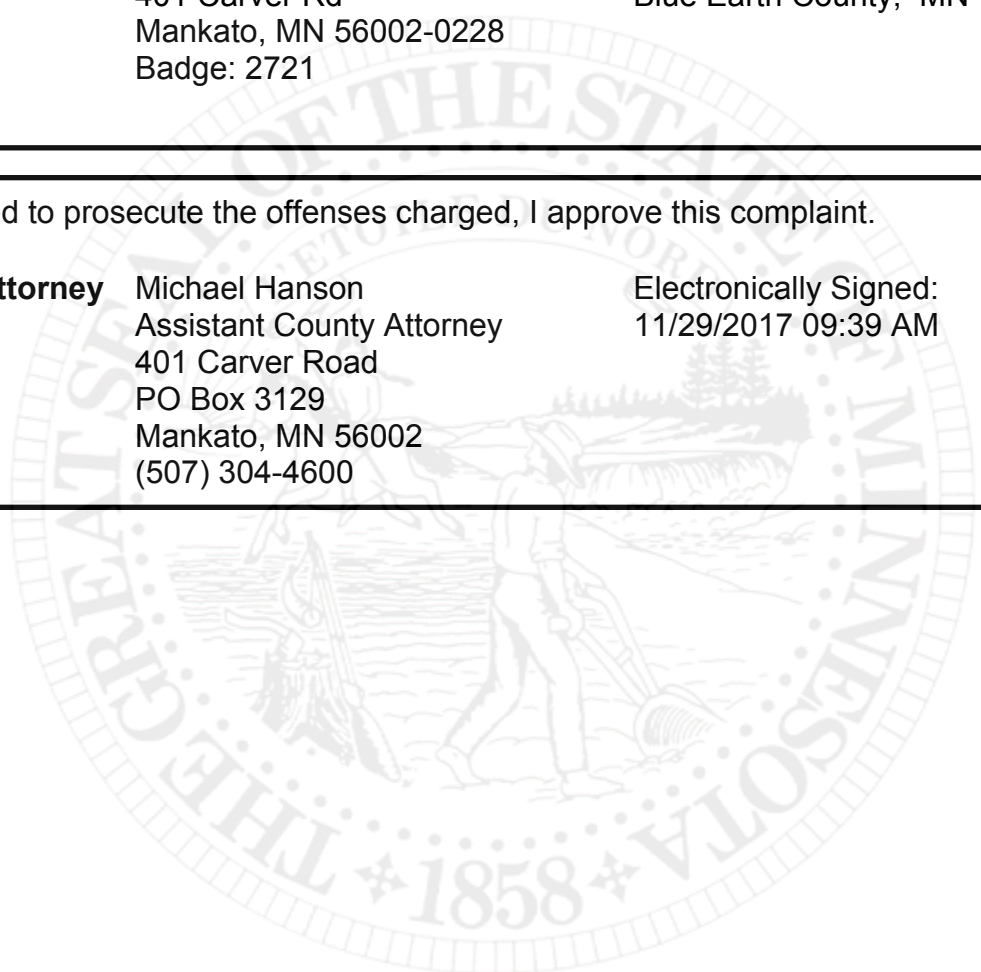

On or about November 8, 2016, in the County of Blue Earth, said Defendant, Taylor Mitchel Spence did vote after having been previously convicted of treason or any felony and their civil rights had not been restored.

**STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE**

On May 1, 2017, Detective Jerry Billiar with the Blue Earth County Sheriff's office was contacted by Witness 1 the Director of Taxpayer Services for Blue Earth County regarding a possible voter law violation by Taylor Mitchel Spence. According to Taxpayer Services, Spence is a potential felon voter from the 2016 general election.

Witness 1 provided a criminal court file number of 22-CR-13-702. Witness 1 had not received voting history for the election yet, so the record remained challenged in Faribault County where the voter originally resided. Based on documents, it appears Spence registered on Election Day through current ID and the registration was accepted by the election judge. The voter record application was completed and signed certifying voting requirements. Spence signed the voter Election Day registration sheet. According to the criminal court file, Spence is on matter supervised probation from February 2014 through February 2019 for a felony level offense.

On May 4, 2017, Detective Billiar checked local records and found the listing for Spence with an address of Winnebago, Minnesota. Detective Billiar also conducted a search of Minnesota driver's license and found Spence had a valid Minnesota driver's license issued in September 2016 with a Mapleton address. Additionally, Detective Billiar reviewed the state-wide supervision system showing an opened case for Spence, indicating Spence is currently on probation which had been transferred to Blue Earth County for a felony level offense.

Based on this information, it is believed Spence registered to vote and voted in the 2016 general election while on supervised release and was therefore a convicted felon in violation of Minnesota registration laws. The Minnesota voter registration application contains the handwritten name of Spence received in the City of Mapleton. The form shows it was completed and signed on November 8, 2016, indicating the application was processed and Spence registered and voted in the election.

On July 26, 2017 Detective Billiar spoke with Spence by telephone. Spence admitted that he had voted in the 2016 general election.

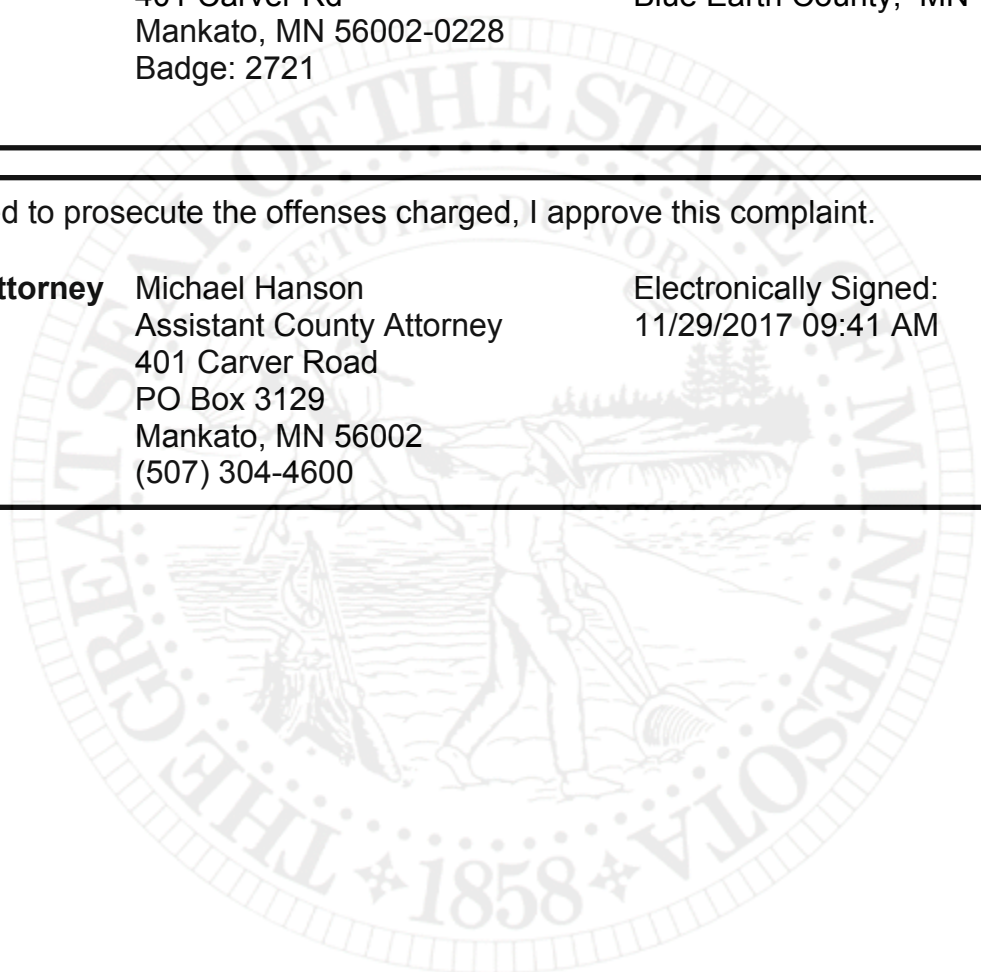



On May 1, 2017 Detective Jerry Billiar with the Blue Earth County Sheriff's Office received information from the Director of Taxpayer Services for Blue Earth County, regarding an allegation that Alysse Miranda Fitzpatrick had registered to vote and voted in the 2016 general election in Blue Earth County while being ineligible to vote.

Fitzpatrick was convicted in January 2014 of a felony Third Degree Controlled Substance crime. Fitzpatrick was placed on probation in January 2014 with a projected probation completion date in 2019. As of May 1, 2017 Fitzpatrick's civil rights have not been restored.

Minnesota statute section 201.014 states that individuals who have been convicted of a felony whose civil rights have not been restored are not eligible to vote. Minnesota statute section 201.054 prohibits an individual to 'cause or attempt to cause the individual's name to be registered in any precinct if the individual is not eligible to vote.'

On November 8, 2016 Fitzpatrick swore or affirmed, by signature on a voter registration form, that she has the 'right to vote because, if convicted of a felony, my felony sentence has expired (been completed) or I have been discharge from my sentence.'

Furthermore, on November 8, 2016, on a Minnesota Voter Registration Application, Fitzpatrick certified that she has the 'right to vote because if I have been convicted of a felony, my felony sentence is expired (been completed) or I have been discharge from my sentence).

On August 14, 2017 Detective Billiar contacted Fitzpatrick. Fitzpatrick admitted that she registered and voted in the 2016 election and confirmed that she was on probation at the time.

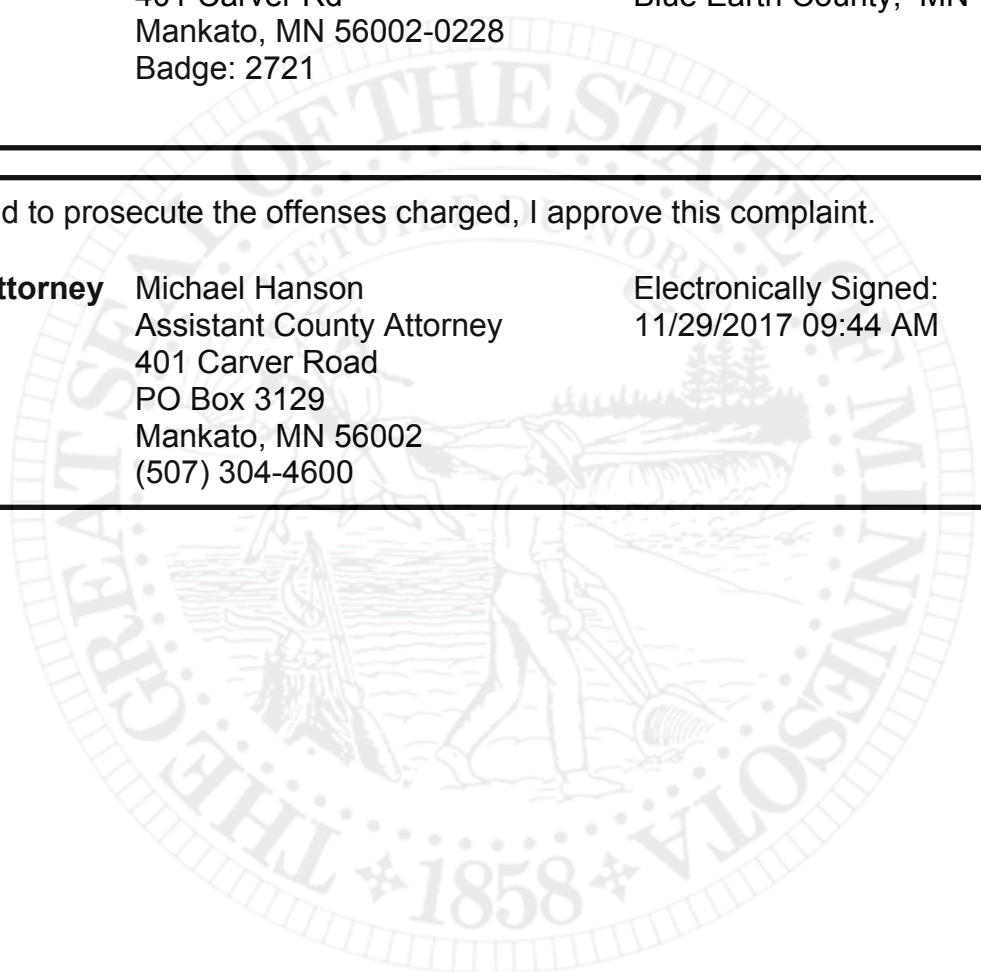


