COUNT 1

The undersigned, under penalty of perjury upon information and belief, declares: That the above named defendant RICHARD ANTHONY HAMILTON committed a violation of Elections Code section 18560, subdivision (b), a felony, in that on or about 6/7/2016, in the County of Riverside, State of California, the defendant, being entitled to vote at an election, voted more than once, and attempted to vote more than once, and knowingly handed in two or more ballots folded together at that election.

COUNT 2

That the above named defendant RICHARD ANTHONY HAMILTON committed a violation of Elections Code section 18560, subdivision (b), a felony, in that on or about 11/8/2016, in the County of Riverside, State of California, the defendant, being entitled to vote at an election, voted more than once, and attempted to vote more than once, and knowingly handed in two or more ballots folded together at that election.
