**MINUTE ENTRY**

**CHANGE OF PLEA**

Defendant present, out of custody.

The Court questions the Defendant regarding his understanding of the terms and conditions of the plea agreement, the possible consequences thereof, and the constitutional rights he waives by entering the plea.

The Defendant enters a plea of guilty to the crime of AMENDED COUNT ONE: ATTEMPTED ILLEGAL VOTING, a Class Six Undesignated Offense, committed on or about October 21, 2016 through November 8, 2016.

Defense counsel provides the Court with the factual basis for the plea, to which the Defendant concurs.

THE COURT FINDS that the Defendant knowingly, voluntarily, and intelligently enters a plea to the charge(s) set forth in the plea agreement, and that there is a factual basis for the plea.

The plea is accepted and entered of record.

Defendant waives time for sentencing.

IT IS ORDERED setting the matter for entry of judgment of guilt and sentencing on October 2, 2019, at 1:30 PM, in Division 17.

IT IS ORDERED that a presentence report be prepared by the Adult Probation Department.

Defendant is directed to cooperate with the probation department in the preparation of the presentence report.

Defendant is advised of the sentencing date and the consequences should he fail to appear.
