INDICTMENT

CHARGING VIOLATIONS OF:

COUNT 1: ILLEGAL VOTING, a Class 5
Felony, in violation of A.R.S. §16-1016(2);

COUNT 2: PERJURY, a Class 4 Felony, in
violation of A.R.S. § 13-2702(A)(2).

The 85th Arizona State Grand Jury accuses **RICHARD JOHN GREENFIELD**,
charging on this 11th day of June, 2019, that in or from Pima County, Arizona:

COUNT 1
ILLEGAL VOTING

During a period beginning on or about October 21, 2016, and ending on or about November 8, 2016, **RICHARD JOHN GREENFIELD**, did knowingly vote more than once at any election, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 16-1016(2), 16-101, 16-1021, 13-701, 13-702 and 13-801.

Said conduct occurred when **RICHARD JOHN GREENFIELD**, voted in the November 8, 2016, General Election in Pima County, Arizona, and in Washoe County, Nevada.

COUNT 2
PERJURY

On or about October 22, 2016, **RICHARD JOHN GREENFIELD**, knowingly made a false unsworn declaration in regard to a material issue that he subscribed as true under penalty of perjury, believing it to be false, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-2702(A)(2), 13-2701, 13-701, 13-702 and 13-801.

Said conduct occurred when **RICHARD JOHN GREENFIELD**, knowingly signed a declaration under penalty of perjury where **RICHARD JOHN GREENFIELD** stated “I declare the following under penalty of perjury: I am a registered voter in Pima County Arizona, I have not voted and will not vote in this election in any other county or state, I understand that knowingly voting more than once in any election is a . . . felony and I voted the enclosed ballot and signed this affidavit personally . . .” when in fact **RICHARD JOHN GREENFIELD** had already voted in the State of Nevada.



Pursuant to A.R.S. § 21-425, the State Grand Jurors find that the offenses described above were committed in Pima County, Arizona.


