JUDGMENT ENTRY
(Community Control Imposed)

On August 14, 2018, the State of Ohio was represented by Assistant Prosecuting Attorney Brian Simms and the Defendant was represented by Attorney Thomas Lininger. The Defendant, after being advised of his rights pursuant to Crim. R. 11, entered a plea of guilty to **Count Four** of the Indictment, to wit: **False Voter Registration**, a violation of Section 3599.11 of the Ohio Revised Code, a Felony of the Fifth degree.

Upon application of the Prosecuting Attorney and for good cause shown, it is ORDERED that a Nolle Prosequi be entered for Counts One, Two, Three and Five of the indictment.

The Court found the Defendant guilty of the charge to which the plea was entered.

The Court proceeded immediately to sentencing.

On August 14, 2018, a sentencing hearing was held pursuant to R.C. 2929.19. The State of Ohio was represented by Assistant Prosecuting Attorney Brian Simms and the Defendant was represented by Attorney Thomas Lininger. The Assistant Prosecuting Attorney and the Defendant's attorney did not recommend a sentence.

The Court afforded counsel an opportunity to speak on behalf of the Defendant and addressed the Defendant personally affording Defendant an opportunity to make a statement on Defendant's own behalf in the form of mitigation and to present information regarding the existence or non-existence of the factors the Court has considered and weighed.

The Court has considered the purposes and principles of sentencing set forth in R.C. 2929.11 and the factors set forth in R.C. 2929.12. In addition, the Court has weighed the factors as set forth in the applicable provisions of R.C. 2929.13 and R.C. 2929.14. The Court further finds that a prison term is not mandatory pursuant to R.C. 2929.13(F).

The Court hereby imposes a period of Community Control for **Two (2) years under Basic Supervision/Direct Placement**. In addition to the provisions of R.C. 2951.02 and the general requirements of the Franklin County Department of Community Control, as authorized by the Common Pleas Court and as given to the Defendant in writing, the Court imposes the following Community Control Sanctions (See R.C. 2929.15, R.C. 2929.16 and R.C. 2929.17.): **Defendant shall obtain/maintain fulltime verifiable employment. Defendant shall have no new convictions or further violations of the law.**

The Court has considered the Defendant's present and future ability to pay a fine and financial sanctions and, pursuant to R.C. 2929.18, hereby renders judgment for the following fine and/or financial sanctions: **No fine imposed. Defendant shall pay court costs in an amount to be determined.**

After the imposition of Community Control, the Court, pursuant to R.C. 2929.19(B)(5) notified the Defendant, orally and in writing, what could happen if Defendant violates Community Control. The Court further indicated that if the Defendant violates Community Control Defendant will receive a prison term of Twelve (12) months at the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction.


The Court finds that the Defendant has **Zero (0) days** of jail time credit and hereby certifies the time to the Ohio Department of Corrections.
