Negotiations placed on the record and confirmed by Defense counsel and Defendant.</p> <p>AS TO COUNT 1:</p> <p>Defendant changes her plea to GUILTY. Defendant was advised of constitutional rights and maximum penalties, waived all rights, plead GUILTY and was examined as to the plea. Plea Questionnaire/Waiver of Rights and Addendum; received and filed. Parties stipulate to the Criminal Complaint as a factual basis for the plea. Defendant further advised that if she is not a US citizen, deportation is possible. Court found Defendant guilty as charged in the Information and ordered entry of Judgment of Conviction. Pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes Section 973.176, the Court advised Defendant that as a convicted felon, she may never possess a firearm, ammunition or body armor. Court advised Defendant that as a convicted felon, her voting rights are suspended, and she may not vote in any election until her civil rights are restored.</p> <p>Court ordered Defendant to provide a DNA Sample and advised Defendant of applicable surcharge.</p> <p>Court advised Defense counsel that one person can speak on behalf of the Defendant, and any other statements must be in writing and provided to the Court three business days prior to the Sentencing hearing.</p> <p>Court ordered case adjourned for Sentencing hearing, Branch 10.</p>
